We have had 2 major services close, decrease in budget in 2nd plan, services that were paid in her first plan cut from her 2nd plan causing us to pay, confusion, lack of compassion, lack of support and the need to complete a 'Review of a reviewable decision' application and awaiting that decision. I am so disappointed. It has stressed the people who are already stressed, the people trying to cope with life the best they can, the people who know and care for their precious loved one. There is a lot more to say but I'm tired of saying it, of whinging, of going over and over all the issues, going round in circles, of nobody caring. It's all in the review application and I hope we are heard.
