From the initial irresponsible idea of building giant 8-lane tollways for individual cars and trucks to be funnelled into the inner city suburbs of Sydney's inner West in spite of all that is known in other large cities of the world about the inefficiency of this type of mass transit, to realising that there was actually no master plan in place and the aim of delivering travellers to the airport was not even going to be achieved (an original goal from 2012), and also realising the real aim of the endeavour was to reap massive profit from taxpayers for the benefit of Toll Road Owners (do any Government ministers have shares in Transurban?) into the future, I am extremely and increasingly annoyed.
