- Artists are largely required to supply their own Public Liability Insurance
- When appearing at (non-alcohol) licenced venues or locations, it is usually in an informal, contained area. Again, Public Liability insurance would be in play. Music licence (APRA) perhaps should be something that could be enforced - BUT given that many of these sites are VOLUNTEER-RUN & NO PAYMENT for appearances are made - This would be a difficult thing to manage.
- There are also <sup>other</sup> music-supportive venues here, including the "TAMWORTH YOUTHIE" where a hall, stage & recording facilities are available for public use; for minimal cost.
