Submission Objection

This proposals makes sense for developers only. Sydney and its environment has been under assault for several years. To destroy 4,700 hectares of a recognised World Heritage area is vandalism when other measures can be taken to control possible flooding such as increased flood forecasting capabilities, adopting world best practice floodplain development controls.

This proposal lacked public consultation, public notification and public support.

Losing 50 Aboriginal sites and over 20 Threatened Species for a possible flooding event is not adequate reasoning.
