POLICE CENTRE OFFICE 14 COLLEGE ST DARLINGHURST NSW CIRCA 1989

The centre entrance was via 14 College St. While I have no recollection if we were signed into the centre at ground floor on arrival I do recall entry to the office on an upper floor where the interview was conducted was via an antechamber / office where there was a secretary who noted out arrival and sat us down while we waited for our meeting. This antechamber was off the corridor from the lift and had no natural light or windows to the outside, however it did have glass-panelled walls on its southern wall - where the lifts were. I have an impression there was more than one desk in this anti chamber. I believe this office was wood panelled.

I recall the office where the meeting occurred was entered through a door from the northern wall of the antechamber, approximately mid way along the southern wall of the office.

The main office was rectangular in shape and spacious – about 10 meters in length and 4 metres width. The north-facing wall was glazed and had views over Sydney CBD and harbour. There were floor to ceiling curtains.

This office was also wood panelled with a large desk positioned at the eastern end and a suite of lounge chairs situated at the western end around a coffee table. The furniture may have been tan leather.

There may have been a second door on the eastern wall beside / to the rear of the desk. The three non-glazed walls were all wood panelled with book shelving and cabinets. I don't recall many books on display and feel the shelves were either empty of had a few objects / framed pictures etc displayed on them.
