I have been visiting apartments on the NSW Central Coast for the past 15 years as part of my work. The apartments vary in age. In that time I have come across approximately 15 buildings that have had major defects. The majority of these defects related to poor or non-existent water proofing. Other defects included:

unsafe balconies that had to be propped up wrong grade of external windows and doors; resulting in the whole of the outside having to be replaced failing expansion joints through the whole of an 8 storey building external building façade crumbling off balcony weep holes covered up causing flooding to units balcony gradients creating flooding into units timber framework traversing adjoining units

The list goes on and on. I have told people what I have witnessed is a crime particularly the fact that it is so widespread and nothing has been done to address the problem, until now.
