As a nurse I transitioned from Manly hospital in October to the Northern beaches hospital. There were nil supplies on our unit for our patients, medications, insulin, pill cups,..the list can go on.

Pts were being sent to Mental health wards without medical clearance and Pts were becoming ill on wards with staff that have not good clinical skills.

Staff had not been orientated to safety doors , pt were able to lock themselves in their rooms, one pt nearly hung on the first day.

From the very first day of opening Pts and staff were not safe, Patients did not have appropriate medications , systems and paperwork were not in place and good management non-existent.
