In all our submissions we, the AKF, have articulated that we do not believe that the New South Wales Government (or any State Government) is capable of protecting the species, and needs federal oversight which is why we want the Koala Protection Act.

This view was supported in the Senate Inquiry Report of 2011 which resulted in the Koala being listed as Vulnerable under the EPBC Act. Since that time (through manipulation of both political parties in Canberra) the EPBC Act has been watered down allowing loopholes to destroy Koala habitats. Memorandum of Understandings were also instigated which has allowed the States to return to normal business practice in the destruction of Koala habitat under their custodianship. I also understand now that there is going to be a re-definition of old-growth forests which is very worrying, unless of course there is genuine intention to protect those areas. Delays have also allowed the Federal Government to avoid their responsibility for a national Koala Recovery Plan which should have been finalised by 2014.

We also draw your attention to our press release where we state that we believe the Koala to be functionally extinct.

I would appreciate being invited to speak to the inquiry – I am confident I could give my thoughts after 32 years of complete inaction by our Governments at all levels to protect the Koala. It is my personal view that if we cannot protect Koala habitat, then every other species is completely at risk.
