SYDENHAM - BANKSTOWN LINE CONVERSION ENQUIRY

I strongly oppose the conversion of the Sydenham to Bankstown Train Line to a Metro Line particularly for the reason that it is an enormous waste of money. The money for conversion should be used to provide a train line in areas where none exists.

The existing Line functions very well, and has been improved over the years at a cost of many millions of dollars to ensure that it is kept up to date and is fit for purpose. This injection of money will be wasted.
