The historical and ongoing actions of the ADB give rise to a severe need to examine the true intent and actions of this taxpayer funded watchdog. The continuing harassment and costly legal processes initiated by Garry Burns and clearly supported by the ADB make an absolute mockery of the true intent of what the ADB should be. The ADB has been pursuing an agenda far beyond its moral duty and fails the 'pub test' with astounding impact.
