For many years we have been deeply concerned by widely known cases such as those of Israel Folau, John Sunol, and Bernard Gaynor. John Sunol is, tragically, a brain-damaged man. Bernard Gaynor has faced 37 complaints since 2014. He does not live in New South Wales. No one in Queensland has complained about him. None of the complaints have been substantiated and the complainant Garry Burns has boasted that he has lodged complaints to bankrupt him.

The NSW Anti-Discrimination Board has refused to even investigate whether Garry Burns' complaints are vexatious and continues to process them.
