Although in principle I agree with the submission that prohibits the unauthorised manufacturer of Firearms, my main concern with this proposal is the prescribed definition of "Firearm Parts". As a compliant, licence firearms owner in NSW, I take enjoyment from my sport, not only from the actual participation of the Competition, but from the minor additions and alterations that I can do with my firearms to make them more accurate or easier to operate. these parts are non-critical to the operation of the firearm, however, would still fall under this ammendment change as "Firearm Parts" and therefore become illegal. My recommendation is to remove the term "Firearm Parts" from this bill. I can't see how this government could enact this ammendment as it stands without intentionally putting its law abiding citizens in direct contradictions with the law. Perhaps the Government could focus its energy on the criminal activities within the state rather than looking at ways to hinder its law abiding constituents.
