The bill in question clearly defines a 'firearm precursor' in a way which means that regardless of whether there is intent or not to illegally manufacture a firearm or part, any of the following materials or tools could be considered now illegal.

Metal - block, sheeting, piping etc., any type of metal etc. Plastic - solid or piping. Workshop machines - lathes, mills, welders, sanders, grinders, drill press. 3d printers - even small personal printers. Workshop tools - screwdrivers, hex screws, allen keys.

You can see from the above list, this legalisation will make the majority of NSW citizens now in possession of illegal materials.

This legislation is not needed.
