We have been the recipients of the various grants made available by all levels of Government, however, we have now been effectively 'closed down' due to the NSW Governments decision to 'Ban Bands'.

Despite this unfair & illogical ban on our business, we will continue to explore innovative ways to stay connected to our students & keep the playing for what appears to be an extended break. To put some perspective to this statement, I would not have grounds to complain if schools were shut down. The fact that children interact at school at close quarters takes away any argument that can be made that a 'clarinet spreads dangerous amounts of aerosols that might be carrying the COVID-19 virus.

I recently submitted an email to Minister Harwin & other Ministers, with the request to issue additional Creative Kids Vouchers (up to 1 per school term).

To date, I haven't received a response & fully understand that this is an exceptionally busy time.
