Enquiry into the Health outcomes and access to health and hospital services in rural, regional and remote New South Wales

I am a resident of the Blue Mountains and a member of the Leura Gardens Festival Committee (<u>www.leuragardensfestival.com.au</u>).

For decades the Festival has raised funds (approximately \$3,000,000) to help support the Blue Mountains District ANZAC Memorial Hospital.

I understand the hospital is one of the **very few** regional hospitals in NSW to have been greatly underfunded for many years and is now in a particularly poor state of repair (leaking roofs etc).

A high percentage of local Mountain residents are forced to travel to Nepean, Westmead and Blacktown Hospitals for treatment that is not available at our own hospital.

Tomorrow I will be driving a friend to Nepean Hospital for her weekly cancer treatment. While there, I will have the opportunity to see the enormous \$500,000,000 development underway at that hospital.

There are possible sites available in the Mountains for a new local hospital, including the current site which could be redeveloped in stages with multi-level buildings and underground carparking (lack of parking is a huge issue at Blue Mountains hospital).
