The attached documents raise issues about

- + equity of access,
- + lack of critical mass effecting the creation of synergies across specialties, the recruitment and retention, of staff.
- + preoccupation with risk/performance based management that dis-empowers clinicians
- + timely serve provision as close to home as possible.

Eg.whilst hospital-in-the-home and telehealth can be beneficial developments, priority must remain with patient centered care and not cost saving for the organization.

- + the serious shortfalls in Aged care package and disability services requiring a more integrated approach of federal and State govt.
- + Work needs to be done to understand and implement the benefits of models of empowerment over the reliance on the 'fix it' approach to medicine . This is particularly important in the provision of mental health services.
