Thank you for your letter dated 14 December 2020. I apologise that it has taken me some time to respond but note that the deadline for submissions is 3 February 2021, so am hopeful that this has not led to any unnecessary delay. I have reviewed your Terms of Reference and the Background to the inquiry that you helpfully linked.

I would like to highlight that the system we have is different to your proposal. There is an intermediate stage between the Commissioner and the House in the form of the Standards Committee or Independent Expert Panel. This allows for an additional independent element in the process, especially in relation to sanctioning, as well as some opportunity for appeal.

I would also draw your attention to the following information included in the links listed below. These provide further guidance and information on my role and the Code of Conduct for members. I have also attached the Commissioner's information note, which gives helpful guidance on how I conduct investigations.
