INQUIRY INTO HEALTH AND WELLBEING OF KANGAROOS AND OTHER MACROPODS IN NEW SOUTH WALES

Dear Sir/Madam, please consider the following...

I live on 16 acres at the very end of the Murray system. I have lived in Adelaide since 1958. I have always paid close attention to the weather. My Dutch parents were strict about total silence when the weather man came on. This was due to their own history being on the North Sea and its violent affects along the coast where I was born.

Australia has dried out like much of the rest of the world. To appreciate this please ask yourself the question: 'If we can see the sun, can the sun see us?'

The temperature data that I have collected starts from 1966. It is based on the minimum temperatures set in the first two weeks of 66,7,8 and 1986,7,8 and 2006,7,8 in the locality of Alice Springs. I was looking at removing the variables and minimum temperatures took out the sun. There is also a wind drop at night, generally.
