I am opposed to the construction of the Beaches Link tunnel as I believe it will cause significant environmental and social damage to the Northern Beaches. For example:

- It will bring more traffic to the Northern Beaches, which is already suffering from congested roads. Instead of a vehicular tunnel, the Northern Beaches needs more public transport eg a rail system which would take traffic off the roads.
