I oppose this development for the following reasons;

1. I don't believe there has not been enough studies done on the impact on local fauna from the drill site at Flat Rock
2. I don't believe there has been enough focus on building business cases for alternative routes and public transport options
3. The fact that the highly populated areas of Sydney's Lower North Shore will end up with a highly concentrated area of unfiltered emissions from several tunnels
4. The suburbs of North Sydney, Cammeray, Naremburn, Willoughby and Northbridge will bear the brunt of 6-7 years of development with little to no benefit for any of the communities
5. The fact that there has been no vision or will in the design to deliver the communities back more green space. Instead this development will reduce the existing amount of green space available to the communities
6. No plan that I have seen is addressing the fact that Flat Rock Drive will be useless as a gateway to schools to and from Crows Nest, the City, numerous schools on the Lower North Shore.
7. No plan has been presented to negate the increased traffic and parking requirements in and around Northbridge and Cammeray. The main traffic arteries in these areas are already congested at peak traffic times.
