I fear of the pollution from the dredging of Sydney Harbour fills me with dread .

As a grandmother I'm also very concerned that there are going to unfiltered stack near schools and homes.

We know that air pollution has been linked to auto immune diseases and that the impact from these unfiltered stacks could have catastrophic affects on the residents who will be subjected to this pollution.

Dr Rut Etzel has written about the effects of pollution on the environment on children and Foetus

We can not take a chance on damaging our children's health

It should be noted that the unfiltered stacks will be in the largest educational area in NSW

30 pre Schools

The risks are too high for children that are there for 8 hours a day

It's also concerning that there are a number of construction sites with explosives near school
