- no business case has been made public which demonstrates the need for, or viability, of these projects.

- no public transport options have been investigated/presented.

- the cost to use these roads will be prohibitive to many resulting in "rat running" through local roads and adversely impacting residents as well as putting pressure on road networks that are not equipped for it I.e. Miller St, Cammeray to North Sydney

- the changes to how those on the lower north shore access the freeway is detrimental, inconvenient and puts undue pressure on the roads in North Sydney.
