The impact of the Tunnel and Warringah Freeway will seriously detrimentally effect traffic who use the Ernest Street entrance and exit to and from the Sydney Harbour Bridge as these will be closed to local traffic and taken over by the Spit and western harbour traffic.

It is almost impossible for local traffic that currently use Ernest street to enter Military road and enter the Bridge entrances. This is because you can rarely legally turn right onto Military road from the north. The result will be that any traffic wanting to go to the city ,eg Opera House or Rocks or CBD will not be able to do so.
