This site has been knocked back on two occasions by Wollondilly Council it is a narrow section of Core Koala habitat, it is a red flagged area & Cumberland plains woodland. Identified in the ecological report for the Greater Macarthur Growth area investigation.

Rob Stokes approved the same DA to be fast tracked under the newly introduced scheme. This occurred after several meetings with Urban Taskforce for of which Mr. Lang Walker recently got himself elected to the executive committee.

This is despite the Chief scientist report recommending the area of Ousedale Creek which flows through this land be preserved for a Koala corridors.
