## Inquiry into the planning and delivery of school infrastructure in New South Wales

Thank you for the invitation to make a submission to the Portfolio Committee 3 – Education inquiry into the planning and delivery of school infrastructure in New South Wales. I welcome the Committee's examination of this important topic.

The effective planning and delivery of infrastructure across all areas of Government service delivery has been and will continue to be a significant focus area for my audit program. I have conducted two performance audits on this topic in the Education cluster in recent years.

In 2017, I released a report titled *Planning for school infrastructure*, which looked at whether the Department had a strategy and implementation model to ensure sufficient fit-for-purpose student learning spaces when and where needed. I found the Department had developed a Strategic Plan with expert input and validation of assumptions to meet future needs. However, successful implementation of the Strategic Plan would require collaboration with other key stakeholders and mitigation of significant risks.

In 2021, I released a report entitled *Delivering school infrastructure*, which focused on the planning and delivery of new, upgraded and redeveloped schools to meet demand for public school education. In this report I found that while the Department had updated and improved its long-term strategic plan, further work needed to be done on developing and advising government on its pipeline of priorities.
