Dear Members of the Inquiry,

Thank you for the opportunity to make a submission to the inquiry planning and delivery of school infrastructure in New South Wales.

I am a parent living in Abbotsford where our local high school is Concord High. We have excellent staff at this school but we are 40% over capacity. There are currently 17 demountables where classes are held and also classes being held in foyers and hallways. In addition to this infrastructure crisis, our school receives below the minimum SRS funding which results in extreme short staffing and large class sizes. These uncomfortable, crowded teaching spaces create a lack of morale and school pride in students. These conditions are simply unacceptable and must be remedied as a matter of urgency with new, permanent structures being built and at least the minimum SRS funding .
