School needs a full 6ft parameter fence - like other public schools in the area. With construction of new housing on Ryans Rd the inadequate fencing poses a safety issue.

Get rid of the septic tanks and connect the school to proper plumbing! Surrounding houses can be and are so why isn't the school?

Major parking issues at pick up time.
