While Animal Welfare is of the highest priority the current bill, whilst well meaning, does not serve it at all.

Puppies and animals deserve to be bred and loved as individuals from birth. They should be raised in the home, in small numbers, not bred in large commercial facilities.

They should be treated as individuals, and particularly historic breeds should be protected and preserved, as they would be if they were museum exhibits.

I would urge the parliament to speak to Dogs NSW when considering this bill to establish correct breeding requirements.
