Hello, I'm writing to oppose the commercial dog breeding facility in NSW.

Firstly, I do not believe companion animals should not be exploited for profit through commercial breeding and intensive housing. Many current a previous dog breeding facilities have serious non-compliance issues, repeated community complaints, notices requiring the unlawful use of the site to cease, community objections, and council staff recommending refusal. Despite all of this, facilities get approved.

Many of these dogs live in squalor and in poor health. Breeds such as the bulldog breeds are bred with serious health issues including breathing difficulties which they live with for their lives. Regulation over this industry is poor. One person alone can be in charge of hundreds of animals, which ultimately WILL result in neglect and abuse.
