Most bus routes along Anzac Parade have been cut from stopping at many bus stops.

This has resulted in loss of options of express buses, routes to and in the city as well as frequency, particularly at night.

It is obvious that the public is being pushed onto the light rail, however the light rail is not only slower, it does not go near enough to work and business places in the areas of St Vincent's Hospital, Hyde Park, Albion and Elizabeth Streets. The light rail also does not have the seating nor frequency of stops to accommodate passengers unable to walk or stand over distances.

The light rail does not have the versatility to match the cost and inconvenience it has caused to the infrastructure and residents along and around Anzac Parade. Even Emergency Services use alternative routes in lieu of Anzac Parade.
