I am an education student about to graduate after 9years of studying a Bachelor of Education (early childhood/primary) part time while having a family. However, due to the covid vaccine mandates, I will not be able to complete my last practical experience and graduate as an early childhood/primary teacher. I am very disappointed that I cannot finish as I am very passionate about educating children and seeing them grow and develop.

If the vaccine mandates are lifted by the education department then I will be able to finish.
