Recent events have also shown that the NSW government's endorsement of the destruction of Mungo man and woman by unauthorised traditional owners by a group of people whose families have actively committed lateral violence against anyone who would oppose their claims and authority by removing my mother, from the AAG using lies and innuendos to drive their claims over other peoples country

After 18 years before getting our determination in 2015 and our part 4a application acceptance the following year we will be left out again by Land Council and others who we feel cannot legitimately represent our Country and Culture, stories and history through this legislation that I am opposed to
