INQUIRY INTO BIRTH TRAUMA

My name is and I wish to tell my traumatic birth experience at Hospital. I was under the care of Dr .. and

On 2nd February 2022 I had a telehealth high risk antennal appointment with Dr I was 38 weeks pregnant at this appointment, my blood pressure was slightly elevated but I was not diagnosed with pre-eclampsia. During my pregnancy my blood pressure was only slightly elevated twice after each time I had a blood pressure study completed and my blood pressure was acceptable and within normal range. During this appointment with Dr ask me if I was going to be induced. I said that my doctor and I were discussing being induced. , midwifery unit manager informed me that she would come back into the room and discuss the induction with me. return into the room and informed me that I would be induced on the 5th Feb 2022 and had written it in the diary without any input from me. This made me feel uncomfortable and scared and I ask why she wanted me to be induced at 37 weeks pregnant, informed me that my pregnancy was high risk and explain why my pregnancy was high risk as this pregnancy was an IVF pregnancy, I had low platelets and gestational diabetes this was control by diet and a had a prior miscarriage and that she wanted all high-risk pregnancy induced early due to 6 other women due to give birth the same week as I. I believe there was no clinal reason for me to be induced at 37 weeks. I that I didn't feel comfortable giving birth that early and that I would need to speak to my husband as he was my support person it was her opinion that I didn't need to discuss the induction with my husband at that at 38 weeks that the baby would be full term. I left the hospital feeling upset and coerced in to having an induction. During my time at the did not give me any information regarding being induced this includes possible complications of being induced.

Thursday 3rd February 2022, my husband and I attended an appointment with Dr at . I was informed that I would be induced on the 13th February 2022 during this appointment there was no discussion of risks of being induced and the reason why I was being induced. I felt pressured by the hospital and by Dr to be induced, I agreed to be induced on Sunday the 13th of February 2022.

Sunday 13th February 2022 at 9:30am I arrived at hospital were Dr applied Cerdvidill to my cervix. Dr did not discuss the procedure to me and didn't discuss possible complications of being induced.

Monday 14th February, Dr check my cervix and informed me that I was not dilated and removed the cervidill. Dr informed me that I had a couple of options moving forward. The first option was he could perform a c- section early Tuesday morning, this made me feel uncomfortable and I felt coerced, the other options was to continue with an induction or going home and waiting for nature labour to take place. I informed DR that if I went

home, I was going to lose my baby, Dr said "He wouldn't recommend for me to going home' I felt that Dr made no effect to reassure me. I agree to have a 2nd cerdvill reapplied. During the course of my treatment, I wasn't informed of possible complications of being induced. From 5pm I started to have regular contractions my contractions were 10 minutes apart, applied electronic monitor attached to a belt around my abdomen, during the monitoring it was left on for 45minutes I was unable to move around and become very distress physically and emotionally and was in lot of physical pain as my contraction were less than 1 minute apart. My husband and I were trying to get someone to give us support but ignored by the midwifes on duty for 45 minutes. We press the buzzer a number of times and my husband went to the nurse station but no one was available to assist me. Finally, attended to my needs and took of monitor and undress me and directed me to the shower and gave me 2 panadeine forte. After I was able to calm down and my contraction slow down but the came unregular during the course of the night.

Tuesday 15th February at 6:30am Dr check my cervix and removed the cerdvidill and informed me that I was 1cm dilated and artificially rupture my membranes. After my membranes ruptured, I started to have contractions every 10 minutes and then 1 contraction every 3 minutes. 11:00 am my contractions begin to slowdown and I started to get anxious, I informed that I was concerned but I was ignored by her. 12:30 Dr came into the delivery room and did a cervical check he did not ask for me permission to do the check, Dr check my cervix and informed me that I was 3cm, I informed him that my contractions had slow down but I was also ignored by him he then informed me if I hadn't made any progress by 7pm that would need a c-section.

1:00pm, I requested to be place on the Syntocinon (oxytocin) infusion as I was concerned that my contractions were irregular. I was given the infusion at 2pm. My contractions become very regular and painful. At 3pm my contractions were intense and I requested an epidural I ask twice for the epidural for the course of 1 hour and half I was offered no other pain relief e.g., gas, hot shower or morphine. Dr admitted the epidural at 4:30pm before the procedure I wasn't informed of the possible complications. After the procedure I was informed that the procedure may not work as there was blood in the epidural line. It was not discussed with me what other options were available.

5:30: Three nurses came in to the delivery room and they bickering who was going to do a cervical check on me this made me feel very uncomfortable and awkward like there was something wrong with me, said fine I will do it. She came into the room and said that I need a cervical check, she did a cervical check and informed me that I was 3cm

Dr came back into the delivery room at 6:30pm and said that he was going to do a cervical check he did not ask for my permission he informed me that my daughter was posterior and high and that I was 2-3 cm (I recently got my noticed and I was actually 3-4cm and was lied to about how dilated I was)and said that I would need to have a C-section at this time I was in shock I couldn't understand what he was saying and he just walked out he didn't give me an opportunity to ask any questions I remember informing me possible compilations of having a C-section but I did not understand her as I couldn't comprehend what was happening around me. Dr come back in to the room and asked me to sign a form to give him permission to perform a C-section I remember signing the form but couldn't

understand what I was signing. I felt that he waited until I could not make decisions or ask questions to perform a C-section and I felt coerced into having a c section.

While The C-section was performed, I remember feeling in shock and thinking negative feelings I wanted to go to sleep to never wake up and at that point I didn't love my daughter and I felt like I was going to hurt her. during a C-section my daughter was placed next to me wrap and during the recovery she was given to me wrapped I wasn't encouraging to do skin to skin with her we didn't have skin to skin or place on my breast to feed her After recovery I was taken back to my room with my husband and my daughter. My daughter was my first child I didn't know how to breastfeed her, I had some colostrum and was not given any direction how to give my daughter colostrum in the freezer Around 2 am and an asked me if I wanted my daughter to be taken to the nursery for us to get some sleep and to I ask to check my daughters glucose checked I agreed for her bloods to be checked and said is she's settled after getting her blood checked to bring her back, I went to sleep as I was exhausted and my daughter wasn't return to 6:30 am my daughter was return to me and I ask how my daughter went and she said she was fine and didn't cry and just went to sleep. I was in shock and didn't understand why my daughter wasn't return to me. Breastfeeding wasn't established until 12:00pm the next day. No one had shown me or offered me assistance to feed my daughter before 12.00pm.

8th April 2022 I informed Dr how I felt regarding my c section, my mental health concerns and how my treatment was handling at hospital. I ask Dr why did he perform the c sections and why did he wasn't he completely honest with me and that I didn't want a c section. Dr informed me that he felt that me having a c section was in the best interest of delivering a healthy baby, this made me feel that I wasn't able to give birth naturally and for my baby to be born healthy. Dr said that pregnancy was an IVF pregnancy, I had low platelets and gestational diabetes this was control by diet and a had a prior miscarriage that having. C- section was in my best interest

I had traumatic experience at hospital I feel that I had an unnecessary c-section and was coerced to being induced and having a c section and I feel that I have lost autonomy and control because it wasn't lifesaving. I didn't feel safe and respected and no one ask me what my birth plan was.

I now suffer from severe postnatal depression, anxiety and severe post-traumatic stress disorder that has greatly affect my life and my relationship with my daughter.

The main issues I am concerned about I wasn't given formal information regarding my treatments; I was coerced into making decision with out informed consent and bully into having an induction and c-section.

I strongly feel that I was coerced and groomed into having an unnecessary c-section Thank you for taking the time to read my story. I can be contacted via mobile or email if you would to discuss my story more.
