As a Dabee Wiradjuri Traditional Owner and Native Title Claimant I do not want our water used for Mining and I do not want the Flora and Fauna subjected to more destruction, loss of habitat, and poisoning of their food sources. Silver and Lead Mining has already harmed our Country and the devastation of local mining sites from 100 years ago has left a toxic legacy still leaching into our life blood the aquifers creeks and rivers of Wiradjuri Country. Only 2 kms from the pit site on private property adjoining the Mine are Aboriginal grinding grooves, artwork and quarries. The dust from the mine will harm the food & wine industry. The dust will affect our childrens health and our childrens childrens health. This Mine should not go ahead
