Silver and Lead Mining has already harmed our Country and the devastation of local mining sites from 100 years ago has left a toxic legacy still leaching into our life blood the aquifers creeks and rivers of Wiradjuri Country . Only 2 kms from the pit site on private property adjoining the Mine are Aboriginal grinding grooves , artwork and quarries . The dust from the mine will harm the food & wine industry . The dust will affect our childrens health and our childrens childrens health . This Mine should not go ahead
