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My daughter is non verbal and has a lot of sensory needs. If she was sent to a government public school she would suffer immensely. She needs a small class and plenty of out door play. That is not sustainable in a public school. Harriet thrives at her beautiful special school. She has one on one care. Is able to regulate with all the beautiful facilities that her school is able to provide for children like her. They are on a farm and get to practice day to day activities, she loves to go there each day. Not all kids are the same and those with higher needs require more specific care. To get rid of these schools would be a dis service to these children, Please re consider your recommendation in regard to abolishing special schools. They are amazing places with amazing people dedicated to our children with extra needs
