To whom it may concern,

I am a resident of Lilyfield and am outraged of the impact the Rozelle interchange has had on our community. I have been a resident of Lilyfield since 2009 and protested against the sweet connexion from the beginning and the impact it would have on traffic, air quality and visual landscape. After being defeated I hoped for the best. After many years of waiting I can't believe what a mess the Rozelle interchange is. I'm furious and angry, here are some examples of how our lives have changed.
