Just making some points regarding the Proposal to sell Rosehill

- How did this proceed so far originally without Member Consultation
- It was stated at the Member Briefing, that Funds are needed to keep NSW Race Tracks operational, and this is the chance. I note:
 - The whole model needs reviewing, i.e.:
 - The Income and Expenditure, prize money model needs to be reviewed for the ATC and RacingNSW. Surely there is some opportunities there to spend wiser
 - Sportsbet, Ladbrokes, Bet365 etc especially the foreign owned online books ... are they paying their way of turnover? The TAB takes the load here
