My name is Tameika Fishlock and I am a resident of the Parkes Shire and I am highly concerned about the long-term impacts that this proposed facility will have not only on our farming community but on the residents and surrounding communities.

I strongly object to the proposed Parkes Energy from waste facility for several reasons. First and foremost is that the Parkes community has not been properly consulted, and important decisions have been made in the background without full transparency to its residents. Important questions like the long-term impact on our health from toxic emissions like dioxins and fine particles are glossed over or simply not answered. This project threatens our clean air, water and soil quality along with our major farming community. The Parkes Shire should not be burdened with Sydney's waste problems when it proposes such a risk.

I oppose this proposal and request that alternative waste management solutions are investigated that do not pose a risk to the environment, human health, and do not cause great distress to host communities. Please recommend that the Government reject Energy from Waste incineration, to protect the health and future of Regional NSW and our agriculture industries.
