Notes and costing assumptions

This policy proposes allocating \$20 million for the NSW Government to partner with not-for-profit mental health organisations. The policy would begin on 1 July 2019, and the funding is to be nominal and paid in \$5 million instalments each year from 2019-20 to 2022-23.

As the policy involves a fixed grant payment, the PBO estimates the cost of the policy to be \$15 million over the forward estimates, with an additional \$5 million paid in 2022-23.
