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Notes and costing assumptions:

The policy commences a comprehensive program of dredging to improve economic and community outcomes across NSW. Costs include:

- 1. Preparation of a comprehensive business case \$300,000
- 2. Improving data collection \$1.4m
- 3. Continuing with interim dredging works on high priority areas \$25.9m
- 4. Expanding project management capabilities \$1.7m
- 5. Contingencies provision \$4.4m

The policy specifies that funding is capped and will be spread over three years, beginning in 2023-24. The total cost of the policy is \$33.7 million over three years. Costs are based on the Transport for NSW Long Term Navigational Dredging Program Strategic Business case.
