#### Notes and costing assumptions:

The policy proposes to cancel the planned Murwillumbah Education Campus project.

The Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) has prepared this costing after consulting with the Department of Education (DoE) and NSW Treasury. The total budget allocation for the project Murwillumbah Education Campus is \$150.5 million to FY 2024-25.

The DoE advised the planned Murwillumbah Education Campus building project is for co-located primary and secondary schools with some shared facilities. The project derives some efficiencies from this shared delivery model. \$23.4 million has already been spent to date and a further \$43.6 million is subject to further contractual commitments.

## Notes and costing assumptions continued:

The PBO notes that if the policy to cancel the Murwillumbah Education Campus project was to proceed in April 2023, a saving of up to \$83.5 million may be available as shown below.
