## Notes and costing assumptions

The policy proposes to not proceed with the Beaches Link project.

## **Key Assumptions:**

The 2022-23 NSW Budget papers have \$4.1 billion allocated to the Western Harbour Tunnel project within the broader Western Harbour Tunnel and Beaches Link (WHT/BL) Program. Transport for NSW advise that budgeted expenditure of \$1.05 million in 2022-23 for the Beaches Link project has already been spent. Therefore there are no savings arising from cancellation of the Beaches Link project.
