## Notes and costing assumptions:

The policy proposes to establish legislation for a whole-of-government approach to suicide prevention, to be modelled on similar legislation in other jurisdictions.

The PBO notes that the suicide prevention policy settings to be covered by the legislation are not yet developed and would not be done until after formation of the Government. The costing assumes that the work to establish legislation can be done with existing resources, both by the Parliamentary Counsel's Office to draft the legislation and within relevant agencies to provide the required instructions. This assumption does not include the nature and scope of suicide prevention policies and measures developed to deliver a whole of government approach.

The indicative cost of establishing this legislation is zero. The costing does not include the cost of any associated policy development or implementation.
