Costing assumptions used:

Netball facility cost is capped at \$27 million,and is to be completed prior to 2015 World Championships. NSW Sport and Recreation have advised that \$4 million allocated in 2010-11, \$10 million in 2011-12 and \$13 million in 2013-14. The PBO assumed that depreciation for the entire facility is 5% per annum (the facility will comprise both building and plant and equipment items, however the PBO does not have sufficient information to break down the costs for each category).

Hockey fields cost is capped at \$5.5 million. NSW Sport and Recreation have advised that \$2 million is to be allocated in 2010-11, \$2 million in 2011-12 and \$1.5 million in 2012-13.

Surf life saving clubs - An Active NSW policy document indicates that \$6 million is to be allocated over the next 3 years. The PBO assumed that \$2 million in grants to surf life saving clubs will be allocated each year.
