Costing assumptions used:

Labor will provide \$500,000 a year to run a community mentoring grants program to help police mentor individuals in ethnic communities.

Funding has been limited to \$500,000 a year so no escalation has been included in the costings.

Funding for the grants program has been assumed to start in year 2011-12.

The replacement of the \$300,000 "Bear Cat", a tactical armoured vehicle for special operations unit within law enforcement agencies has been assumed to take place in 2011-12 on 1 July.

Depreciation expenses have been assumed at 25% p.a.
