

9 SELECTION OF BILLS COMMITTEE—REPORT

The Chair (Mr Nanva) tabled Report No. 6 of the Selection of Bills Committee, dated 22 August 2023.

Mr Nanva moved, according to standing order: That the following bills not be referred to a standing committee for inquiry and report this day:

- (a) Crimes Amendment (Breaking and Entering) Bill 2023,
- (b) Drug Misuse and Trafficking Amendment (Appointed Persons) Bill 2023,
- (c) Electoral Funding Amendment Bill 2023,
- (d) Forestry Amendment (Timber Harvesting Safety Zones) Bill 2023,
- (e) ICAC and LECC Legislation Amendment Bill 2023,
- (f) Revenue, Fines and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2023, and
- (g) Road Transport Amendment (Medicinal Cannabis) Bill 2023.

Debate ensued.

Mr Rath moved: That the question be amended as follows:

- (1) Omit paragraph (c), and
- (2) Insert after paragraph (1):

"(2) That:

- (a) the Electoral Funding Amendment Bill 2023 be referred to Portfolio Committee No. 1 – Premier and Finance for inquiry and report, and
- (b) the committee report by 11 September 2023."

Debate continued.

Question put: That the amendment of Mr Rath be agreed to.
