

19 ORDER FOR PAPERS—NORTHERN RIVERS RECONSTRUCTION CORPORATION

Ms Higginson, by leave, amended private members' business item no. 177 as follows:

- (1) Omit "21 days" and insert instead "28 days".
- (2) Omit "the Minister for Regional NSW, Minister for Agriculture, Minister for Western NSW and the Department for Regional NSW" and insert instead "the Minister for Agriculture, Minister for Regional New South Wales and Minister for Western New South Wales, the Minister for Customer Service and Digital Government, Minister for Emergency Services and Minister for Youth Justice, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, or the NSW Reconstruction Authority".

Ms Higginson moved, according to notice, as by leave amended, private members' business item no. 177: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 28 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents, excluding any documents previously returned under an order of the House, created since 28 February 2022, in electronic format if possible, in the possession, custody or control of the Minister for Agriculture, Minister for Regional New South Wales and Minister for Western New South Wales, the Minister for Customer Service and Digital Government, Minister for Emergency Services and Minister for Youth Justice, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, or the NSW Reconstruction Authority relating to the Northern Rivers Reconstruction Corporation:

- (a) all documents relating to the draft Resilient Lands Strategy,
- (b) all documents relating to the Resilient Homes Program,
- (c) all documents relating to the Flood Hazard Information that has been produced in support of the Resilient Homes Program, and
- (d) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.
