5 2023-2024 BUDGET (Formal Business)

Mr Tudehope moved, as formal business, private members' business item no. 434: That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 21 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents, excluding the Budget Papers for the financial year 2023-2024, in electronic format if possible, in the possession, custody or control of the Premier, the Treasurer, the Minister for Finance and Minister for Natural Resources, Treasury, the Premier's Department or The Cabinet Office relating to the 2023-2024 budget:

- (a) all advice, correspondence, briefing papers and documents provided by New South Wales government departments, agencies and public trading enterprise sectors to the Treasurer, Treasury the Premier's Department or The Cabinet Office relating to the 2023-2024 budget, including but not limited to:
 - (i) any documents that assess the impact of any of the measures outlined in the budget,
 - (ii) any models or documents that estimate the revenues to be raised as a result of the measures outlined in the budget,
- (b) all advice, correspondence, briefing papers, budget kits and budget electorate reports provided to any members of Parliament relating to the 2023-2024 budget handed down on 19 September 2023,
- (c) any documents provided to individual members of Parliament outlining regional electorate capital works summaries, by electorate, including but not limited to documents described as electorate reports and regional reports in Prime the financial management system used by Treasury,
- (d) any documents which refer to capital expenses by electorate, by agency, funded by appropriations from Parliament as well as funds from asset sales and other sources, including but not limited to documents described as electorate reports and regional reports in Prime the financial management system used by Treasury,
- (e) any other documents which refer to capital and recurrent expenses by electorate, including but not limited to documents described as electorate reports and regional reports in Prime the financial management system used by Treasury, and
- (f) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.
