

**28 ORDER FOR PAPERS—LOCAL SMALL COMMITMENTS ALLOCATION – FURTHER ORDER**

Mr Rath moved, according to notice, private members' business item no. 1891:

- (1) That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 21 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents, excluding any documents previously returned under an order of the House, created since 28 March 2023 in the possession, custody or control of the Premier, the Special Minister of State, Minister for Transport, Minister for the Arts and Minister for Music and the Night-time Economy, the Treasurer, the Minister for Families and Communities and Minister for Disability Inclusion, The Cabinet Office, the Treasury or the Department of Communities and Justice relating to the Local Small Commitments Allocation:
  - (a) all documents relating to the Local Small Commitments Allocation,
  - (b) all documents relating to Tranche 7, including any cancelled briefs,
  - (c) all documents relating to the Sydney electorate,
  - (d) all documents relating to Premier's Discretionary Fund expenditure in the Electorate of Sydney,
  - (e) all documents relating to grant funding for the Salvation Army in the Electorate of Sydney, and
  - (f) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.
  
- (2) That, under standing order 52, there be laid upon the table of the House within 21 days of the date of passing of this resolution the following documents, excluding any documents previously returned under an order of the House, created since 28 March 2023 in the possession, custody or control of the Premier or the Premier's Department relating to the Local Small Commitments Allocation:
  - (a) the following documents relating to the Local Small Commitments Allocation identified by the Premier's Department in the return received on Friday 31 January 2025 to the order of the House of Wednesday 20 November 2024:
    - (i) all briefs and attachments provided to the Special Minister of State, Minister for Transport, Minister for the Arts and Minister for Music and the Night-time Economy including assessment outcome reports,
    - (ii) all emails, advice or other correspondence to or from members of parliament or ministerial offices,
    - (iii) all documents relating to program financial management, including delegation instruments or the program operating expenditure budget,
    - (iv) all individual conflict of interest declarations, conflict of interest summaries or management controls for members of parliament, candidates, assessors, or staff in the Local Small Commitments Allocation program office,
    - (v) all correspondence with successful or unsuccessful grantees,
    - (vi) all grant variation requests or decisions,
    - (vii) all policy or process documents,
    - (viii) all legal advice,
  - (b) all documents relating to Tranche 7, including any cancelled briefs,
  - (c) all documents relating to the Sydney electorate,

- (d) all documents relating to Premier's Discretionary Fund expenditure in the Electorate of Sydney,
- (e) all documents relating to grant funding for the Salvation Army in the Electorate of Sydney, and
- (f) any legal or other advice regarding the scope or validity of this order of the House created as a result of this order of the House.
